THE GROWING NUMBERS AND INCREASING PROPORTIONS OF PEOPLE LIVING IN URBAN AREAS HAS SEVERED AN IMPORTANT CONNECTION TO NATURE AND LED TO SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN WESTERN ATTITUDES TOWARD WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT.







Those who live with and among wild animals must be allowed to determine how best to manage their needs and control their interaction with humans.

Balanced and sustained use of Africa's wildlife resources is an African imperative.

While the interest, advice and assistance of outside groups in the management and well-being of wildlife resources is always welcomed, their ex parte involvement in national policy determinations and their use of budgetary incentives to influence governmental decisions can no longer be tolerated.
